## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5506a. (1) If an application for a new or renewal permit under this part is filed on or after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section, the application and permit, if issued, shall include a plan for the appropriate reduction of emissions to protect air quality on winter thermal inversion action
