Rep. Kuppa offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare May 2021 as Asian Pacific American 2 Heritage Month in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, The state of Michigan is fortunate to be home to more 4 than 330,000 residents of Asian and Pacific Island descent; and Whereas, Asian Pacific Americans comprise one of the fastest-5 6 growing populations in both the state and the nation. In fact, this 7 group is the largest-growing population in Michigan according to 8 the last U.S. Census; and 9 Whereas, The Asian and Pacific Island regions are tremendously diverse; with more than thirty countries, numerous languages, and 10 11 multiple belief systems; and 12 Whereas, Citizens of Asian and Pacific Island descent in each 13 generation, rom the laborers who connected our coasts one and a

- 2 families were interned at home, to the entrepreneurs and engineers
- 3 who help our economy thrive, and our healthcare professionals who
- 4 have served to ensure public health during the pandemic, these
- 5 patriotic Americans have enhanced our culture, quality of life, and
- 6 economic vitality through leadership, commitments to knowledge,
- 7 education, and advancement, and dedication to their communities;
- 8 and
- 9 Whereas, The state of Michigan and the United States of
- 10 America have been enriched by the contributions of Asian Pacific
- 11 Americans in all facets of life, including the arts, sciences,
- 12 business, education, and philanthropy. Michigan has recognized the
- 13 contributions Asian Pacific Americans and other immigrants make to
- 14 our economy with the establishment of the Michigan Asian Pacific
- 15 American Affairs Commission and Office of Global Michigan; and
- 16 Whereas, The culture and contributions of our Asian and
- 17 Pacific Island residents will continue to grow in significance as
- 18 more Asian Pacific Americans choose to make Michigan their home and
- 19 as our economy becomes increasingly intertwined with the economies
- 20 throughout Asia; and
- 21 Whereas, Asian Pacific Americans, through advocating issues of
- 22 justice and equality, continue to break down the barriers of
- 23 discrimination, indifference, and intolerance, thereby opening
- 24 doors for all Asian Pacific Americans; and
- 25 Whereas, Asian Pacific American residents are proudly served
- 26 in Michigan by many dedicated organizations, including Asian
- 27 Pacific American Chamber of Commerce, Council of Asian Pacific
- 28 Americans, Asian American Citizens for Justice, Asian Center
- 29 Southeast Michigan and West Michigan, West Michigan Asian Pacific

- 1 American Association, APIA-Vote Michigan, Michigan Asian Pacific
- 2 American Bar Association, South Asian Bar Association of Michigan,
- 3 South Asian American Voices for Impact, MI-India Foundation, India
- 4 League of America-Michigan, Asian Indian Women's Association of

- 6 Whereas, The state of Michigan takes pride in its cultural
- 7 diversity and welcomes the opportunity to honor our Asian Pacific
- 8 American residents for their lasting, expanding imprint upon our
- 9 state; now, therefore, be it
- 10 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 11 this legislative body declare May 2021 as Asian Pacific American
- 12 Heritage Month in the state of Michigan. We encourage all citizens
- 13 to celebrate the individual and collective contributions of Asian
- 14 Pacific Americans to this state and to this country.
