The bill would amend Chapter 83 (Of marriage and the solemnization thereof) of the Revised Statutes of 1846 to align the provisions of Section 16 with the provisions proposed in <u>Senate Bill 1044 (S-2)</u>. Senate Bill 1044 (S-2) would allow a civil celebrant, a township supervisor, or a State legislator to solemnize (officially perform) a marriage. "Civil celebrant" would mean an individual who was at least 18 years of age and who worked in accordance with the wishes of the client couple.

The bill is tie-barred to Senate Bill 1044.
