- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- (a) "Community district education trust fund" means thecommunity district education trust fund created in section 12.

- 1 received under section 21(7) of the use tax act, 1937 PA 94, MCL
- 2 205.111, or from any other source in the fund. The state treasurer
- 3 shall direct the investment of money in the fund and credit

- 6 in the fund and does not lapse to the general fund.
