SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5987

A bill to amend 1980 PA 300, entitled "The public school employees retirement act of 1979," by amending section 85 (MCL 38.1385), as amended by 2006 PA 617.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 85. (1) A retiring member or retiring deferred member who 2 meets the requirements of section 81 or 81a or a member whom the 3 retirement board finds to be totally and permanently disabled and eligible to receive a retirement allowance under section 86 or 87 4 shall elect to receive his or her the member's retirement allowance 5 6 under 1 of the payment options provided in this subsection. The 7 election shall must be in writing and filed with the retirement board at least 15 days before the effective date of the retirement 8 allowance except as provided for a disability retirant under 9

- 1 section 86 or 87. The amount of retirement allowance under
- 2 subdivision (b), (c), or (d) shall must be the actuarial equivalent
- 3 of the amount of retirement allowance under subdivision (a). The
- 4 Subject to subsection (12), the options are as follows:
- 5 (a) A retirant shall will be paid a straight retirement
- 6 allowance for life computed pursuant to under section 84. An
- 7 additional retirement allowance payment shall must not be made upon
- 8 on the retirant's death.
- 9 (b) A retirant shall will be paid a reduced retirement
- 10 allowance for life with the provision that upon on the retirant's
- 11 death, payment of the reduced retirement allowance is continued
- 12 throughout the lifetime of the retirement allowance beneficiary
- 13 whom the member or deferred member designates in a writing filed
- 14 with the retirement board at the time of election of this option. A
- 15 member or deferred member may elect this option and designate a
- 16 retirement allowance beneficiary under the conditions set forth in
- **17** section 82(2) or 89(3).
- 18 (c) A retirant shall will be paid a reduced retirement
- 19 allowance for life with the provision that upon on the retirant's
- 20 death, payment of 1/2 of the reduced retirement allowance is
- 21 continued throughout the lifetime of the retirement allowance
- 22 beneficiary whom the member designated in a writing filed with the
- 23 retirement board at the time of election of the option.
- 24 (d) On and after January 1, 2000, After December 31, 1999, a
- 25 retirant shall will be paid a reduced retirement allowance for life
- 26 with the provision that upon on the retirant's death, payment of
- 27 75% of the reduced retirement allowance is continued throughout the
- 28 lifetime of the retirement allowance beneficiary whom the member
- 29 designated in a writing filed with the retirement board at the time

1 of election of the option.

- (2) In addition to the election under subsection (1), a 2 retirant, other than a disability retirant who is 60 years of age 3 or less, may elect to coordinate his or her retirement allowance 4 5 with an estimated primary social security benefit. 6 The retirant shall must be paid an increased retirement allowance 7 until 62 years of age and a reduced retirement allowance after 62 8 years of age. The increased retirement allowance paid until 62 9 years of age shall must approximate the sum of the reduced 10 retirement allowance payable after 62 years of age and the 11 retirant's estimated social security Social Security primary 12 insurance amount. The retirement system shall determine the 13 estimated social security Social Security primary insurance amount. 14 shall be determined by the retirement system. The election under 15 this subsection shall must be made at the same time and in the same 16 manner as required under subsection (1).
 - (3) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the election of a payment option in subsections (1) and (2) shall must not be changed on or after the effective date of the retirement allowance. Except as provided in this section, the retirement allowance beneficiary selected under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) shall must not be changed on or after the effective date of the retirement allowance and shall must be either a spouse, brother, sister, parent, or child, including an adopted child, of the member, deferred member, retiring member, or retiring deferred member entitled to make the election under this act. Another retirement allowance beneficiary shall must not be selected. If a member, deferred member, retiring member, or retiring deferred member is married at the retirement allowance effective date, an

- 15 must revert to a straight retirement allowance including post-
- 16 retirement adjustments, if any, shall be is effective the first of

- 18 the remainder of the retirant's life. This subsection applies to a
- 19 retirant whose effective date of retirement is after June 28, 1976,
- 20 but the straight retirement allowance shall must not be payable for

- 5 (5) A retirant who returns to service pursuant to under

- 9 allowance beneficiary pursuant to under subsection (1)(b), (c), or

- 11 (6) If a retirant receiving a reduced retirement allowance
- 12 under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) is divorced from the spouse
- 13 who had been designated as the retirant's retirement allowance
- 14 beneficiary under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d), the retirement
- 15 system shall consider the election of a reduced retirement
- 16 allowance payment option shall be considered void by the retirement

- 6 retirement allowance under this subsection effective the first of
- 7 the month after the date the retirement system receives a certified
- 8 copy of the judgment of divorce or award or order of the court.
- 9 This subsection does not supersede a judgment of divorce or award
- or order of the court in effect on June 27, 1991. This subsection
- 11 does not require the retirement system to distribute or pay
- 12 retirement assets on behalf of a retirant in an amount that exceeds
- 13 the actuarially determined amount that would otherwise become
- 14 payable if a judgment of divorce had not been rendered.
- 15 (7) If the retirement allowance payments terminate before an
- 16 aggregate amount equal to the retirant's accumulated contributions
- 17 has been paid, the difference between the retirant's accumulated
- 18 contributions and the aggregate amount of retirement allowance
- 19 payments made shall must be paid to the person individual
- 20 designated in a writing filed with the retirement board on a form
- 21 provided by the retirement board. If the designated person
- 22 individual does not survive the retirant or retirement allowance
- 23 beneficiary, the difference shall be paid to the deceased
- 24 recipient's estate or to the legal representative of the deceased
- 25 recipient.
- 26 (8) A retirant who selected a retirement allowance beneficiary
- 27 under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) may change his or her
- 28 retirement allowance beneficiary if all of the following apply:
- 29 (a) The first retirement allowance beneficiary is a spouse.

- (b) The first retirement allowance beneficiary predeceases the
 retirant after the retirement allowance effective date.
- 3 (c) The retirant marries another spouse after the retirement4 allowance effective date.
- (d) The retirant files a written request with the retirement 5 6 system to name his or her current spouse as a retirement allowance 7 beneficiary not earlier than 180 days and not later than 1 year 8 after the marriage of the retirant and the current spouse except 9 that a retirant whose first retirement allowance beneficiary 10 predeceases the retirant after the retirement allowance effective 11 date and before the effective date of the amendatory act that added 12 this subsection shall have January 1, 2009 has 180 days from the 13 effective date of the amendatory act that added this subsection 14 after January 1, 2009 to file a written request with the retirement 15 system.
 - (9) A retirant who was not married on his or her the retirant's retirement allowance effective date and who did not select a payment option provided in this section may select an optional form of benefit payment under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) and designate a retirement allowance beneficiary if all of the following apply:
 - (a) The retirant marries after his or her the retirant's retirement allowance effective date.
- (b) The retirement allowance beneficiary is the retirant'sspouse.
- (c) The retirement allowance beneficiary is only designated as the retirement allowance beneficiary for that portion of the retirant's retirement allowance that is not subject to an eligible domestic relations order assigning a previous spouse a reduced

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- benefit under section 4(b) of the eligible domestic relations order
 act, 1991 PA 46, MCL 38.1704.
- (d) The retirant files a written request with the retirement 3 system to select the optional form of benefit payment under 4 5 subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) and to designate his or her spouse 6 as the retirement allowance beneficiary, not earlier than 180 days 7 and not later than 1 year after the retirant's marriage except that 8 a retirant who marries after the retirement allowance effective 9 date and before the effective date of the amendatory act that added 10 this subsection shall have January 1, 2009 has 180 days from the 11 effective date of the amendatory act that added this subsection
- 12 after January 1, 2009 to file a written request with the retirement system.

 14 (10) The retirement allowance of the retirant who makes an
 - (10) The retirement allowance of the retirant who makes an election under subsection (8) or (9) shall must not be greater than the actuarial equivalent of the retirement allowance as determined by the retirement board that the retirant would otherwise be entitled to under subsection (1)(a) and shall must become effective the first day of the month following after the filing of the written request with the retirement system.
 - (11) If the retirant dies no not later than 12 months after the effective date of his or her the retirant's election under subsection (8) or (9), the retirement allowance for the surviving spouse established under subsection (8) or (9) shall must terminate 12 months after the death of the retirant.
 - (12) If a retirement allowance beneficiary selected under subsection (1)(a) to (d) is a beneficiary of a trust established under 42 USC 1396p(d)(4)(A) or (C), the retirement allowance payable to the retirement allowance beneficiary may be paid by the

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- 1 retirement system to the trust on written direction to the
- 2 retirement system by the retirant or, after the retirant is
- 3 deceased, by the retirement allowance beneficiary or by the
- 4 retirement allowance beneficiary's legal representative if the
- 5 retirement allowance beneficiary is a minor or is incapacitated.
