 - (4) If the paternity of a child is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, the name of the father shall must be entered on the certificate of birth as found and ordered by the court. The surname of the child shall must be entered on the certificate of birth as designated by the child's mother.
 - (5) If the child's father is not named on the birth registration, no other information about the father shall may be entered on the registration.
- (6) A child conceived by a married woman with consent of her
 husband following the utilization of assisted reproductive
 technology is considered to be the legitimate child of the husband
 and wife.
 - (7) After May 30, 1979, a birth certificate shall must not

contain a reference to the legitimacy or illegitimacy of a child.
