

HOUSE BILL NO. 5218

October 24, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Hill and Scott and referred to the Committee on Energy, Communications, and Technology.

A bill to require certain reports be submitted to the Michigan public service commission; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commission.
- 3 (b) "Utility" means that term as defined in section 6g of 1939
- 4 PA 3, MCL 460.6g.
- 5 Sec. 3. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2),

1 beginning May 1, 2024, and by the first day of each month
2 thereafter, a utility that submits any of the following report
3 forms to the United States Energy Information Administration shall
4 also submit a copy of each report form to the commission:

5 (a) EIA-782C: Monthly Report of Prime Supplier Sales of
6 Petroleum Products Sold for Local Consumption.

7 (b) EIA-810: Monthly Refinery Report.

8 (c) EIA-815: Monthly Bulk Terminal and Blender Report.

9 (d) EIA-816: Monthly Natural Gas Liquids Report.

10 (2) The commission may develop and make available on its
11 website report forms that are substantially similar to and include
12 all of the same informational sections as the report forms listed
13 under subsection (1). If the commission develops and makes
14 available report forms under this subsection, a utility that is
15 required to submit a report form under subsection (1) may submit
16 either a report form developed under this subsection or a report
17 form described under subsection (1).

18 (3) A report form submitted under this section is exempt from
19 disclosure under the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL
20 15.231 to 15.246.
