

HOUSE BILL NO. 5451

February 14, 2024, Introduced by Reps. Brixie, MacDonell, Glanville, Rheingans, Conlin, Dievendorf, Byrnes, Wilson, Brabec, Martus, Paiz and Weiss and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1313b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1313b. (1) Beginning October 1, 2025, and every October 1
2 thereafter, the board of a school district or intermediate school
3 district, the board of directors of a public school academy, or the
4 governing body of a nonpublic school, as applicable, shall
5 distribute the informational notice developed under section 1313a

1 to the parent or legal guardian of each student enrolled in the
2 school district, intermediate school district, public school
3 academy, or nonpublic school. The informational notice may be
4 distributed electronically or by mail.

5 (2) By not later than October 1, 2025, the department shall
6 post the informational notice developed under section 1313a on the
7 department's website in English, Spanish, and Arabic.

8 (3) By not later than October 1, 2025, the board of a school
9 district or intermediate school district, the board of directors of
10 a public school academy, and the governing body of a nonpublic
11 school, as applicable, shall post links to the department webpages
12 described in subsection (2) on the website of the school district,
13 public school academy, or nonpublic school, as applicable.

14 (4) The department, the department of health and human
15 services, a school district or intermediate school district, a
16 public school academy, a nonpublic school, and any officers, board
17 members, or employees of those institutions are immune from civil
18 liability, both personally and professionally, for any damages
19 allegedly caused by, arising out of, or relating to the
20 informational notice developed under section 1313a.

21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
22 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 5450 (request no.
23 03162'23) of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
