A bill to amend 2014 PA 461, entitled "Human trafficking health advisory board act," by amending section 3 (MCL 752.993).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The human trafficking health advisory board is
- 2 created as an autonomous entity within the department of community
- 3 health and human services. The board shall consist of the following
- 4 members:
- 5 (a) The director of the department of **health and** human

- 8 must be licensed or authorized to engage in the practice of
- 9 medicine under part 170 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 10 333.17001 to 333.17084, **333.17097**, or part 175 of the public health
- 11 code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.17501 to 333.17556.
- 12 (d) One individual appointed by the governor from a list of 3
- 13 individuals submitted by the speaker of the house of
- 14 representatives. The individual must be licensed or authorized to
- 15 engage in the practice of medicine under part 170 of the public
- 16 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.17001 to 333.17084, 333.17097, or
- 17 part 175 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.17501 to
- **18** 333.17556.
- 19 (e) One individual appointed by the governor who has
- 20 experience and expertise in the field of intervention in or
- 21 prevention of human trafficking or treatment of human trafficking
- 22 survivors.
- (f) Two individuals appointed by the governor who are human
- 24 trafficking survivors.
- 25 (g) One individual appointed by the governor who is a mental
- 26 health professional.
- 27 (h) One individual appointed by the governor who is a
- 28 registered professional nurse licensed to engage in the practice of
- 29 nursing under part 172 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL

- 1 333.17201 to 333.17242, and who is experienced in an emergency
- 2 department, emergency room, or trauma center of a hospital licensed
- 3 under article 17 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- **4** 333.20101 to 333.22260.**333.22121.**
- 5 (2) The members first appointed to the board under subsection
- 6 (1)(c) to (h) shall be appointed within 90 days after the effective
- 7 date of this act.by April 14, 2015.
- 8 (3) Of the members initially appointed to the board under
- 9 subsection (1)(c) to (h), 1 member shall be appointed for a term
- 10 that expires on December 31, 2015, 1 member shall be appointed for
- 11 a term that expires on December 31, 2016, 2 members shall be
- 12 appointed for a term that expires on December 31, 2017, and 3
- 13 members shall be appointed for terms that expire on December 31,
- 14 2018. At the expiration of an initial appointment, a member shall
- 15 be appointed for a term of 4 years.
- 16 (4) A member who attends less than 66 percent of the scheduled
- 17 meetings of the board in any calendar year shall be is considered
- 18 to have vacated his or her appointment. Upon On notification of a

- 20 shall fill the vacancy in the same manner as the original
- 21 appointment.
- 22 (5) The governor may remove a member of the board for
- 23 incompetence, dereliction of duty, malfeasance, misfeasance, or
- 24 nonfeasance in office, or any other good cause.
- 25 (6) The first meeting of the board shall must be called not
- 26 more than 180 days after the effective date of this act. later than
- 27 July 13, 2015. Before this first meeting, the governor shall
- 28 appoint the chairperson of the board from among the members listed
- 29 in subsection (1). At the first meeting, the board shall elect from

- 1 among its members a vice-chairperson and other officers as it
- 2 considers necessary or appropriate who shall serve 1-year terms and
- 3 who may be reelected. After the first meeting, the board shall meet
- 4 at least quarterly, or more frequently at the call of the

- 6 serving.
- 7 (7) A majority of the members of the board constitute a quorum
- 8 for the transaction of business at a meeting of the board. A
- 9 majority of the members present and serving are required for the
- 10 official action of the board.
- 11 (8) The business that the board may perform shall must be
- 12 conducted at a public meeting of the board held in compliance with
- 13 the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 14 (9) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 15 retained by the board in the performance of an official function is
- 16 subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231
- **17** to 15.246.
- 18 (10) Members of the board shall serve without compensation.
- 19 However, members of the board may be reimbursed for their actual
- 20 and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their
- 21 official duties as members of the board.

- 23 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5477 (request no.
- 24 01038'23) of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
