HOUSE BILL NO. 6206

November 26, 2024, Introduced by Rep. Skaggs and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1177 (MCL 380.1177), as amended by 2013 PA 121.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1177. (1) A child enrolling in a public or nonpublic
- 2 school for the first time or , beginning in the 2014-2015 school
- 3 year, enrolling in grade 7 for the first time shall submit 1 of the
- 4 following:

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- (b) A statement signed by a parent or quardian to the effect that the child has not been immunized because of religious convictions or other objection to immunization. For any immunization described in subdivision (a) for which a statement is not submitted under subdivision (a) or (c), a signed and completed medical contraindication form described in section 9215(3) of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.9215, or a signed and completed nonmedical immunization waiver form described in section 9215(4) of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.9215.
- 14 (c) A statement signed by a physician that certifies that the15 child is in the process of complying with all immunization16 requirements.

- (2) In addition, the parent or guardian of each child enrolling in kindergarten for the first time shall submit a statement signed by a district, county, or city health department director stating that the child has been administered the department of community health and human services preschool vision screening test, or signed by a licensed medical or osteopathic physician or a licensed optometrist stating that the child's eyes have been examined during the preschool years after age 3 and before initial entrance. A vision test is not required if there is a statement signed by a parent or guardian to the effect that the child cannot be submitted to the test because of religious convictions.
 - (3) Not later than November 1 of each year, the administrator

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- 1 of each school shall provide the director of the department of
- 2 community health and human services with the immunization status of

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- 3 each pupil in grades K through to 12 who enrolled in the school for
- 4 the first time, or , beginning in the 2014-2015 school year,
- 5 enrolled in grade 7 in the school for the first time, between the
- 6 immediately preceding January 1 and the immediately preceding
- 7 September 30, as well as a vision report of each child entering
- 8 kindergarten during that time period. This information shall must
- 9 be transmitted through the approved local full-time health
- 10 department, if available, and shall must be on forms provided by
- 11 the director of community health and human services or otherwise
- 12 reported in a manner approved by the director of the department of
- 13 community health. health and human services. Not later than
- 14 February 1 of each year, the administrator of each school shall
- 15 provide an update to the report due the previous November 1 to show
- 16 the immunization status of each pupil in grades K through to 12 who
- 17 enrolled in the school for the first time, or , beginning in the
- 18 2014-2015 school year, enrolled in grade 7 in the school for the
- 19 first time, during the calendar year ending the immediately
- 20 preceding December 31. This information shall must be transmitted
- 21 in the same manner as the report due the previous November 1.
- 22 (4) The department of community health and human services
- 23 shall promulgate rules, including rules identifying the diseases
- 24 specified under subsection (1)(a), for the implementation of this
- 25 section.
