- (p) "Wolf-dog cross" means a canid resulting from the breeding

- 25 (i) A wolf with a dog.
- 26 (ii) A wolf-dog cross with a wolf.
- 27 (iii) A wolf-dog cross with a dog.
- 28 (iv) A wolf-dog cross with a wolf-dog cross.
