

# SENATE BILL NO. 33

January 19, 2023, Introduced by Senator SANTANA and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to require that the pre-incarceration address of incarcerated individuals be reported when providing information for voting district population counts; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state officers and entities.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

- 1           Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2           (a) "Department" means the department of corrections.
- 3           (b) "Pre-incarceration address" means the address at which an
- 4 incarcerated individual resided before the individual's current
- 5 incarceration.

1           Sec. 2. For purposes of reporting the residency of an  
2 individual who is incarcerated in a correctional institution  
3 operated by the department, as that information relates to a  
4 population count that is used for the establishment of a voting  
5 district, the department shall report the individual's pre-  
6 incarceration address.
