

SENATE BILL NO. 169

March 09, 2023, Introduced by Senator CHERRY and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend 1947 PA 336, entitled

"An act to prohibit strikes by certain public employees; to provide review from disciplinary action with respect thereto; to provide for the mediation of grievances and the holding of elections; to declare and protect the rights and privileges of public employees; to require certain provisions in collective bargaining agreements; to prescribe means of enforcement and penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to make appropriations,"

(MCL 423.201 to 423.217) by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 11a. (1) Not later than 30 days after a public employer

1 hires a public employee, the public employer shall provide the
2 employment and contact information of the public employee to the
3 representative of the public employee as described in section 11.
4 Every 90 days, a public employer shall provide to each
5 representative of its public employees the employment and contact
6 information of the public employees represented by that
7 representative.

8 (2) The employment and contact information provided under
9 subsection (1) must include all of the following for each employee:

- 10 (a) Name.
- 11 (b) Department or agency.
- 12 (c) Job title.
- 13 (d) Address of primary work location.
- 14 (e) Home address.
- 15 (f) Personal telephone number.
- 16 (g) Personal email address.
