A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 147d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 147d. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3),
- 2 a person, acting under color of any law, that for any reason
- 3 willfully subjects an individual to the deprivation of any rights,
- 4 privileges, or immunities secured or protected by the Constitution
- 5 of the United States, the state constitution of 1963, the laws of
- 6 this state, or the laws of the United States, or to different
- 7 punishments, pains, or penalties than are prescribed for the

- 1 punishment of other individuals, is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 2 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, a fine of not
- 3 more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 4 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), if a violation of
- 5 subsection (1) causes bodily injury or if the violation of
- 6 subsection (1) includes the use, attempted use, or threatened use
- 7 of a dangerous weapon, explosives, or fire, the person is quilty of
- 8 a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 10 years, a
- 9 fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
- 10 (3) If the violation of subsection (1) causes a death or if
- 11 the violation of subsection (1) included acts amounting to
- 12 kidnapping or attempted kidnapping, criminal sexual conduct or
- 13 attempted criminal sexual conduct, or murder or attempted murder,
- 14 the person is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for

- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
