HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

Reps. Brixie and Witwer offered the following concurrent resolution:

A concurrent resolution to waive the legislative notice
requirement for increases in rates of compensation for certain
employees in the state classified service.

Whereas, The Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963 provides in Article XI, Section 5:

Increases in rates of compensation authorized by the commission may be effective only at the start of a fiscal year and shall require prior notice to the governor, who shall transmit such increases to the legislature as part of his budget. The legislature may, by a majority vote of the members elected to and serving in each house, waive the notice and permit increases in rates of compensation to be effective at a time other than the start of a fiscal year.

Whereas, Agreements were reached between the state and the 1 2 Michigan Corrections Organization, AFSCME Council 25, the Michigan 3 State Employees Association, the Service Employees International Union Local 517M Scientific and Engineering Unit, the Service 4 5 Employees International Union Local 517M Technical Unit, the UAW 6 International and its Local 6000 to increase rates of compensation 7 for exclusively represented positions in certain classifications; 8 and 9 Whereas, On July 25 and December 19, 2022, the Civil Service 10 Commission approved the agreements, and also approved increases in 11 the rates of compensation for non-exclusively represented positions in certain classifications, past the time when the Governor could 12 transmit the increases as part of the budget; now, therefore, be it 13 14 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate 15 concurring), That, pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963, the Michigan 16 Legislature waives the prior notice requirement to permit increases 17 18 in rates of compensation as described in the approved agreements 19 between the state and exclusive representatives for exclusively 20 represented positions, and as approved by the Civil Service 21 Commission for non-exclusively represented positions; and be it 22 further 23 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
