I would like to recognize the Marquette Junior Hockey American Legion Post 44 14U Bantam AA hockey team. These boys won the Michigan Amateur Hockey Association (MAHA) State Tournament on March third, beating the Kalamazoo K-Wings in a closely contested 3-2 victory on home ice in Marquette's Lakeview Arena in front of 2,000 proud supporters, parents, grandparents, and fans.

They now will travel to Amherst, New York to compete in the USA Hockey 14U Tier 2 National Tournament representing the entire state of Michigan as they compete for the national title at their age level.

These boys have overcome adversity and were not the favorites to win the state title. This is a group of 13- and 14-year-old boys that put the individual aside and truly played for the name on their chest and their teammates. Their success allows them to join six previous Marquette teams over 34 years to attain this level and to realize that together they can accomplish great things.
