Senator Bellino introduced

Senate Bill No. 977, entitled

A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled “Michigan memorial highway act,” (MCL 250.1001 to 250.2092) by adding section 115.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Veterans and Emergency Services.

Senator Bellino introduced

Senate Bill No. 978, entitled

A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled “Michigan memorial highway act,” (MCL 250.1001 to 250.2092) by adding section 6d.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Veterans and Emergency Services.

Senator Chang introduced

Senate Bill No. 979, entitled

A bill to amend 1972 PA 348, entitled “An act to regulate relationships between landlords and tenants relative to rental agreements for rental units; to regulate the payment, repayment, use and investment of security deposits; to provide for commencement and termination inventories of rental units; to provide for termination arrangements relative to rental units; to provide for legal remedies; and to provide penalties,” (MCL 554.601 to 554.616) by adding section 1c.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Housing and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled “The social welfare act,” (MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 14q.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Housing and Human Services.

Senator Cavanagh introduced

Senate Bill No. 981, entitled

A bill to amend 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, entitled “Michigan employment security act,” by amending sections 3, 4, 5, 5a, 5b, 6a, 8, 9, 10, and 10a (MCL 421.3, 421.4, 421.5, 421.5a, 421.5b, 421.6a, 421.8, 421.9, 421.10, and 421.10a), section 3 as amended by 2003 PA 174, section 4 as amended and section 5b as added by 2002 PA 192, section 5 as amended by 1983 PA 164, section 5a as amended by 2017 PA 227, section 6a as amended by 2011 PA 269, section 8 as amended by 1996 PA 535, section 10 as amended by 2016 PA 517, and section 10a as added by 2011 PA 268; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Labor.

Senators Singh and Lauwers introduced

Senate Bill No. 982, entitled

A bill to amend 1883 PA 129, entitled “An act for the organization of telephone and messenger service companies,” (MCL 484.1 to 484.10) by adding section 7.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

Senators Lauwers and Singh introduced

Senate Bill No. 983, entitled

A bill to amend 1993 PA 23, entitled “Michigan limited liability company act,” by amending section 705a (MCL 450.4705a), as amended by 2014 PA 559.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

Senators Singh and Lauwers introduced

Senate Bill No. 984, entitled

A bill to amend 1972 PA 284, entitled “Business corporation act,” by amending section 123 (MCL 450.1123), as amended by 2012 PA 569.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

Senator Klinefelt introduced

Senate Bill No. 985, entitled

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled “Natural resources and environmental protection act,” by amending section 52706 (MCL 324.52706), as amended by 2012 PA 488.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

Senator Anthony introduced

Senate Bill No. 986, entitled

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled “Food law,” by amending section 4105 (MCL 289.4105), as amended by 2016 PA 188.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

Senator McMorrow introduced

Senate Bill No. 987, entitled

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled “The insurance code of 1956,” (MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406kk.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

Senator McMorrow introduced

Senate Bill No. 988, entitled

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled “The social welfare act,” (MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 109p.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.
