**Introduction and Referral of Bills**

Senator Hertel introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1111, entitled**

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled “The insurance code of 1956,” by amending sections 3403, 3406z, 3406bb, and 3406ii (MCL 500.3403, 500.3406z, 500.3406bb, and 500.3406ii), section 3403 as amended by 2023 PA 158, section 3406z as added by 2023 PA 159, section 3406bb as added by 2023 PA 160, and section 3406ii as added by 2023 PA 157.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

Senators McCann, Irwin, Chang, McBroom and Cavanagh introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1112, entitled**

A bill to amend 1976 IL 1, entitled “A petition to initiate legislation to provide for the use of returnable containers for soft drinks, soda water, carbonated natural or mineral water, other nonalcoholic carbonated drink, and for beer, ale, or other malt drink of whatever alcoholic content, and for certain other beverage containers; to provide for the use of unredeemed bottle deposits; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,” by amending the title and sections 1, 2, 3c, and 3e (MCL 445.571, 445.572, 445.573c, and 445.573e), section 1 as amended by 1989 PA 93, section 2 as amended by 1998 PA 473, section 3c as amended by 2022 PA 198, and section 3e as added by 1996 PA 384, and by adding sections 2b, 3g, and 5a; to repeal acts and parts of acts; and to provide for a referendum.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Energy and Environment.

Senators McCann, Irwin, Chang, Cavanagh and McBroom introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1113, entitled**

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled “Income tax act of 1967,” by amending section 695 (MCL 206.695), as amended by 2023 PA 4.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Energy and Environment.

Senators Irwin and Shink introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1114, entitled**

A bill to regulate the use by law enforcement agencies of minors as law enforcement participants and informants; and to provide for the issuance of injunctive orders and payment of damages under certain circumstances.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

Senators Irwin and Shink introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1115, entitled**

A bill to amend 2004 PA 47, entitled “Medical records access act,” by amending sections 3 and 9 (MCL 333.26263 and 333.26269), section 3 as amended by 2008 PA 124.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Housing and Human Services.

Senators McMorrow, Damoose, Irwin, Polehanki, Chang, Shink and Cavanagh introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1116, entitled**

A bill to amend 1984 PA 270, entitled “Michigan strategic fund act,” (MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094) by amending the title, as amended by 2005 PA 225, and by adding section 9c.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Economic and Community Development.

Senators Damoose, McMorrow, Polehanki, Chang, Shink and Cavanagh introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1117, entitled**

A bill to amend 1984 PA 270, entitled “Michigan strategic fund act,” (MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094) by adding sections 9a and 9b.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Economic and Community Development.

Senators Shink, McMorrow and Cavanagh introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1118, entitled**

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled “The Michigan penal code,” by amending section 520a (MCL 750.520a), as amended by 2023 PA 65, and by adding section 520p.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

Senators Shink, Polehanki and McMorrow introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1119, entitled**

A bill to amend 1966 PA 189, entitled “An act to provide procedures for making complaints for, obtaining, executing and returning search warrants; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,” by amending section 1 (MCL 780.651), as amended by 2014 PA 383.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

Senators Shink, Polehanki and Cavanagh introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1120, entitled**

A bill to amend 1966 PA 189, entitled “An act to provide procedures for making complaints for, obtaining, executing and returning search warrants; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,” by amending section 1 (MCL 780.651), as amended by 2014 PA 383.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

**Senate Bill No. 1121, entitled**

A bill to amend 1969 PA 226, entitled “Critical health problems education act,” by amending section 3 (MCL 388.383).

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Education.

**Senate Bill No. 1122, entitled**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled “Natural resources and environmental protection act,” (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 149.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Energy and Environment.

Senators Shink, Polehanki, Cavanagh and McMorrow introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1123, entitled**

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled “The revised school code,” by amending sections 1169 and 1170a (MCL 380.1169 and 380.1170a), section 1169 as amended by 2004 PA 165 and section 1170a as added by 2016 PA 388.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Education.

Senators Shink, Polehanki and Cavanagh introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1124, entitled**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled “Natural resources and environmental protection act,” by amending section 503 (MCL 324.503), as amended by 2018 PA 240, and by adding section 502c.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Agriculture.

Senators Shink and Polehanki introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1125, entitled**

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled “The general property tax act,” by amending section 27 (MCL 211.27), as amended by 2022 PA 240.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Finance, Insurance, and Consumer Protection.

Senator Camilleri introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1126, entitled**

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled “The insurance code of 1956,” by amending sections 2212e and 3425 (MCL 500.2212e and 500.3425), section 2212e as added by 2022 PA 60 and section 3425 as amended by 2016 PA 276.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Finance, Insurance, and Consumer Protection.

**Senate Bill No. 1127, entitled**

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled “The social welfare act,” (MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 109t.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

**Senate Bill No. 1128, entitled**

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled “The insurance code of 1956,” (MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406jj.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

**Senate Bill No. 1129, entitled**

A bill to amend 2011 PA 152, entitled “Publicly funded health insurance contribution act,” by amending section 4 (MCL 15.564), as amended by 2013 PA 271.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Labor.

Senator Hertel introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1130, entitled**

A bill to amend 2011 PA 152, entitled “Publicly funded health insurance contribution act,” by amending section 3 (MCL 15.563), as amended by 2018 PA 477.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Labor.

**Senate Bill No. 1131, entitled**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled “Natural resources and environmental protection act,” by amending section 1301 (MCL 324.1301), as amended by 2018 PA 451, and by adding subchapter 6 to chapter 3 of article III.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Energy and Environment.

Senator Bellino introduced

**Senate Bill No. 1132, entitled**

A bill to amend 1929 PA 16, entitled “An act to regulate the business of carrying or transporting, buying, selling, or dealing in crude oil or petroleum or its products, or certain substances consisting primarily of carbon dioxide through pipe lines; to authorize the use of public highways and the condemnation of private property; to regulate the purchase and storage of crude oil or petroleum or certain substances consisting primarily of carbon dioxide; to provide for the control and regulation of all corporations, associations, and persons engaged in such business, by the Michigan public service commission; to define the powers and duties of the commission in relation thereto; and to prescribe penalties,” by amending section 1 (MCL 483.1), as amended by 2014 PA 85.

The bill was read a first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Energy and Environment.
