

## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 113

Senators Theis, Albert, Bellino, Daley, Damoose, Hoitenga, Huizenga, Johnson, Lauwers, Moss, Nesbitt, Outman, Polehanki and Webber offered the following resolution:

1           A resolution to recognize April 29, 2024, as End Jew-Hatred  
2 Day.

3           Whereas, For millennia, the Jewish people have sustained their  
4 shared religious, cultural, and ethnic identity and traditions in  
5 the face of enslavement, persecution, genocide, segregation and  
6 discrimination; and

7           Whereas, The Jewish community has continued to be subjected to  
8 antisemitism and Jew-hatred, including discrimination in the  
9 workplace, on school campuses, and in public spaces; and

10           Whereas, Hate crimes directed against the Jewish community

1 have skyrocketed in recent years, inspiring and empowering Jewish  
2 people to discover and embrace their heritage, without fear of  
3 attack or persecution; and

4       Whereas, We all share an obligation to condemn and combat Jew-  
5 hatred in all of its forms; and

6       Whereas, We recognize the urgent need to stand against Jew-  
7 hatred so that the intergenerational trauma of the past shall never  
8 be repeated; now, therefore, be it

9       Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative  
10 body recognize April 29, 2024, as End Jew-Hatred Day; and be it  
11 further

12       Resolved, That we set aside political differences, unite with  
13 singular purpose to condemn Jew-hatred in all of its forms, and  
14 stand resolute to end the discrimination and persecution of the  
15 Jewish people.
