A bill to amend 2004 PA 46, entitled "Public safety officers benefit act,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 28.632), as amended by 2016 PA 284.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Commission" means the commission on law enforcement
- 3 standards created under the Michigan commission on law enforcement
- 4 standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.616.28.615.

- (b) "County medical examiner" means an individual appointed as a county medical examiner under 1953 PA 181, MCL 52.201 to 52.216.
- (c) (b) "Dependent" means any individual who was substantially
 reliant for support upon on the income of the a deceased public
 safety officer.
- 6 (d) "Deputy county medical examiner" means an individual
 7 appointed as a deputy county medical examiner under 1953 PA 181,
 8 MCL 52.201 to 52.216.
- 9 (e) (c) "Direct and proximate" means that the antecedent event
 10 is a substantial factor in the result.
- (f) (d)—"Firefighter" means a regularly employed member of a fire department of a city, county, township, village, state university, or community college or any authority, district, board, or other entity created in whole or in part by 1 or more cities, counties, villages, or townships, or a member of the department of natural resources who is employed to fight fires. Firefighter includes a part-time or volunteer member of a fire department.
- 23 (h) (f) "Line of duty" means either 1 of the following:
- (i) Any action which that an officer whose primary function is crime control or reduction, enforcement of the criminal law, or suppression of fires is obligated or authorized by rule, regulations, condition of employment or service, or law to perform, including those social, ceremonial, or athletic functions to which the officer is assigned, or for which the officer is compensated,

- 20 (k) (h) "Member of a rescue squad or ambulance crew" means an
- 21 emergency medical technician, a medical first responder, or a
- 22 paramedic, as those terms are defined in sections 20904, 20906, and
- 23 20908 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20904,
- 24 333.20906, and 333.20908, or an officially recognized or designated
- 25 employee or volunteer member of a rescue squad or ambulance crew.
- 26 (l) (i) "Permanent and total disability" means medically
- 27 determinable consequences of a catastrophic, line-of-duty injury
- 28 that permanently prevent a former public safety officer from
- 29 performing any gainful work.

- (m) (i) "Public safety officer" or "officer" means any 1 2 individual serving a public agency or any authority, district, board, or other entity created in whole or in part by 1 or more 3 cities, counties, villages, or townships, in an official capacity, 4 with or without compensation, as a law enforcement officer, 5 firefighter, or member of a rescue squad or ambulance crew, county 6 7 medical examiner, deputy county medical examiner, or medical 8 examiner investigator.
- 9 (n) (k)—"Surviving spouse" means the husband or wife spouse of 10 the deceased officer at the time of the officer's death, and 11 includes a spouse living apart from the officer at the time of the officer's death for any reason.
