THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1290. (1) The board of a school district or intermediate
- 2 school district shall not prohibit the participation of an eligible
- 3 child in any extracurricular activities offered by a school
- 4 operated by the board.

- 1 (2) The board of a school district or intermediate school
- 2 district shall ensure that the school district or intermediate
- 3 school district is not a member of an athletic conference or
- 4 statewide interscholastic athletic association and does not
- 5 participate in events operated or sponsored by a conference or
- 6 association that has a policy, bylaw, rule, or regulation that
- 7 prohibits an eligible child's participation in any interscholastic
- 8 athletics offered by a school operated by the board.
- 9 (3) As used in this section:
- 10 (a) "Eligible child" means a child who meets all of the
- 11 following criteria:
- 12 (i) Resides within the school district or intermediate school
- 13 district that offers the extracurricular activities that the child
- 14 is seeking to participate in under subsection (1).
- 15 (ii) Is being homeschooled or attending a nonpublic school
- 16 during the child's participation in the extracurricular activities
- 17 described in subsection (1).
- 18 (iii) Meets all other applicable eligibility standards for
- 19 participation in the extracurricular activities.
- 20 (b) "Extracurricular activities" includes, but is not limited
- 21 to, the following activities that are offered by a school district
- 22 or intermediate school district:
- 23 (i) Interscholastic athletics.
- 24 (ii) Theater or drama productions.
- 25 (iii) Band, orchestra, or other musical programs.
- 26 (iv) Debate team.
