## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4907**

September 11, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Prestin, Martin, Schuette, Alexander and Wozniak and referred to Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 407, entitled "Skilled trades regulation act,"

by amending section 907 (MCL 339.5907), as amended by 2020 PA 89.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 907. (1) The Subject to subsection (3), the department,
- 2 in consultation with the board, shall promulgate rules for the safe
- 3 construction, installation, inspection, alteration, servicing,
- 4 operation, and repair of boilers in this state. For purposes of
- 5 this subsection, the department by rule may adopt or amend all or

- 1 any part of an existing published codification or national
- 2 standards and any amendments and interpretations of the
- 3 codification or standards.
- 4 (2) A departure from the requirements of this section is
- 5 permitted in an unusual situation involving a boiler of special
- 6 design or construction if the board is satisfied that a proposed
- 7 facility will provide a degree of safety commensurate with the
- 8 intent of this article.
- 9 (3) The department shall not promulgate or enforce a rule that
- 10 restricts a class 5B boiler installer or a class IV boiler repairer
- 11 from completing periodic maintenance and testing of controls and
- 12 safety devices of a boiler system.
- (4) (3) If the department receives an application and the
- 14 appropriate fee, the board may without examination register an
- 15 applicant for the use of a title described in section 931 if the
- 16 applicant is a boiler operator or stationary engineer who is
- 17 licensed or registered as a boiler operator or stationary engineer
- 18 in another state or country or in a municipality whose requirements
- 19 for licensure or registration are, at a minimum, substantially
- 20 equivalent to the requirements of this state for registration, as
- 21 determined by the board, and that other state or country or that
- 22 municipality extends the same privileges through reciprocity to a
- 23 boiler operator or stationary engineer who is registered in this
- 24 state.
- 25 (5) R 339.5206 of the Michigan Administrative Code is
- 26 rescinded.
- 27 (6) As used in this section:
- 28 (a) "Class 5B boiler installer" means an individual who has a
- 29 class 5B installer's license as described in R 339.5174 of the

- 1 Michigan Administrative Code.
- 2 (b) "Class IV boiler repairer" means an individual who has a
- 3 class IV license as described in R 339.5175 of the Michigan
- 4 Administrative Code.
