A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending section 2004 (MCL 339.2004), as amended by 2016 PA 435.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

 18 in engineering from an accredited program or its—the equivalent of
 19 a baccalaureate degree, as determined by the board of professional

 to practice professional engineering acceptable to the department

- 7 (c) Pass the professional surveying fundamentals and
 8 professional practice examinations or provide equivalent proof of
 9 qualification to practice professional surveying acceptable to the
 10 department and the board.
