A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17731 (MCL 333.17731), as amended by 2014 PA  $_{\rm 285}$ .

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17731. (1) Notwithstanding the requirements of part 161, 2 the board may require either of the following:
- 3 (a) That a licensee seeking renewal of a pharmacist's license
- 4 furnish the department with satisfactory evidence that, during the

- ${f 1}$  2 years immediately preceding application for renewal,  ${f he}$  or she
- 2 attended the licensee completed continuing education courses or
- 3 programs, approved by the board, totaling not less than 30 hours or
- 4 satisfactorily completed a proficiency examination according to
- 5 rules promulgated by the department in consultation with the board.
- 6 (b) That a licensee seeking renewal of a pharmacy technician's
- 7 license furnish the department with satisfactory evidence that,
- 8 during the 2 years immediately preceding application for renewal,
- 9 he or she has attended the licensee completed at least 20 hours of
- 10 continuing education courses or programs, approved by the board, or
- 11 satisfactorily completed a proficiency examination according to
- 12 rules promulgated by the department in consultation with the board.
- 13 (2) The department in consultation with the board shall
- 14 promulgate rules requiring each applicant for license renewal to
- 15 complete as part of the continuing education or proficiency
- 16 examination requirement of subsection (1) an appropriate number of
- 17 hours or courses in pain and symptom management.
- 18 (3) The department shall allow for 100% of the continuing
- 19 education required under this section to be earned through online
- 20 or electronic media. An online or electronic media must meet
- 21 standards approved by the department in consultation with the
- 22 board.
