HOUSE BILL NO. 4937

September 11, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Fairbairn, Bohnak, Markkanen, Prestin, Alexander, DeSana, St. Germaine, Schriver, Fox and Woolford and referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43528 (MCL 324.43528), as amended by 2013 PA 108.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 43528. (1) An individual shall not hunt bear unless the 2 individual possesses a bear hunting license. However, an individual
- 3 who goes on a bear hunt with a licensed hunter is not required to
- 4 possess a bear hunting license if the individual does not carry a
- 5 firearm, bow, or crossbow and does not own dogs used to chase or

- 1 locate bear during the hunt. Beginning March 1, 2014, only Only an
- 2 individual holding a valid base license is eligible to purchase a
- 3 bear hunting license, pursuant to in accordance with current
- 4 regulations.
- 5 (2) The fee for a resident bear hunting license is \$15.00. The
- 6 fee for a nonresident bear hunting license is \$150.00. Beginning
- 7 March 1, 2014, the fee for a bear hunting license is \$25.00.
- 8 (3) The department may issue a kill tag with, or as a part of,
- 9 a bear hunting license. The kill tag shall must bear the license
- 10 number. The kill tag may also include space for other pertinent
- 11 information required by the department. The kill tag, if issued, is
- 12 part of the license.
- 13 (4) In addition to the license fees in subsection (2), the
- 14 department shall charge a nonrefundable application fee not to
- 15 exceed \$4.00 for each individual who applies for a bear hunting
- 16 license. Beginning March 1, 2014, in addition to the license fees
- 17 in subsection (2), the department shall charge a nonrefundable
- 18 application fee not to exceed \$5.00 for each individual who applies
- 19 for a bear hunting license.
- 20 (5) Beginning March 1, 2014, the The following individuals
- 21 chasing or locating bear with dogs during the open season for that
- 22 game and who hold a valid base license are eligible for the
- 23 purchase of a bear participation license for a fee of \$15.00:
- 24 (a) Any individual possessing a firearm, crossbow, or bow and
- 25 arrow.
- 26 (b) The owner, when present, of any dog chasing or locating
- **27** bear.
- 28 (6) An individual holding a valid base license is eligible to
- 29 purchase a bear backup hunting license, in accordance with current

- 1 regulations. The fee for a resident bear backup license is \$50.00.
- 2 The fee for a nonresident bear backup license is \$250.00. A bear
- 3 backup hunting license allows the holder of that license to
- 4 accompany a licensed bear hunter and shoot a bear that has already
- 5 been wounded by the hunter. A bear backup hunting license is
- 6 subject to all of the following:
- 7 (a) Is valid for the entire bear season.
- 8 (b) Can be used an unlimited number of times to accompany an
- 9 unlimited number of hunters.
- 10 (c) Is valid in all bear management units in this state.
