A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending sections 3208 and 3212 (MCL 600.3208 and 600.3212), section 3212 as amended by 2019 PA 142.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3208. (1) Notice that the a mortgage will be foreclosed under this chapter by a sale of the mortgaged premises, or some part of them, shall the premises, must be given by publishing the same notice for 4 successive weeks at least once in each week, in a newspaper published in the county where the premises included in

- 1 the mortgage and intended to be sold, or some part of them, are
- 2 situated. the premises, is located. If no newspaper is published in
- 3 the county, the notice shall must be published in a newspaper
- 4 published in an adjacent county. In every case within
- 5 (2) Within 15 days after the first publication of the notice
- 6 under subsection (1), a true copy shall—or the notice must be
- 7 posted in a conspicuous place upon on any part of the premises
- 8 described in the notice.
- 9 (3) If the sale of the premises is to be held online, the
- 10 person conducting the sale shall post notice of the sale on the
- 11 website of the county in which the premises, or part of the
- 12 premises, is located and shall give notice of the sale by any other
- 13 means that the person considers necessary to ensure that the public
- 14 is aware of the sale.
- Sec. 3212. (1) A notice of foreclosure by advertisement must
- 16 include all of the following:
- 17 (a) The names of the mortgagor, the original mortgagee, and
- 18 the foreclosing assignee, if any.
- 19 (b) The date of the mortgage and the date the mortgage was
- 20 recorded.
- 21 (c) The amount claimed to be due on the mortgage on the date
- 22 of the notice.
- 23 (d) A description of the mortgaged premises that substantially
- 24 conforms with the description contained in the mortgage.
- 25 (e) A description of the property by giving its street
- 26 address, if any. The validity of the notice and the validity of any
- 27 eventual sale under this chapter are not affected by the fact that
- 28 the street address in the notice is erroneous or that the street
- 29 address is omitted.

- 1 (f) For a mortgage executed after December 31, 1964, the2 length of the redemption period as determined under section 3240.
- 3 (g) A statement that if the property is sold at a foreclosure 4 sale under this chapter, under section 3278 the borrower will be 5 held responsible to the person who buys the property at the 6 mortgage foreclosure sale or to the mortgage holder for damaging 7 the property during the redemption period.
- 8 (h) The name, address, and telephone number of the attorney9 for the party foreclosing the mortgage.
- 10 (i) For a residential mortgage, a statement in the following
 11 form: "Attention homeowner: If you are a military service member on
 12 active duty, if your period of active duty has concluded less than
 13 90 days ago, or if you have been ordered to active duty, please
 14 contact the attorney for the party foreclosing the mortgage at the
 15 telephone number stated in this notice.".
- 16 (j) A statement Statements in the following form:
- (i) "Notice of foreclosure by advertisement. Notice is given 17 18 under section 3212 of the revised judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 19 236, MCL 600.3212, that the following mortgage described in this 20 notice will be foreclosed by a sale of the mortgaged premises, or 21 some part of them, the mortgaged premises, at a public auction sale 22 to the highest bidder for cash or cashier's check at the place of holding the circuit court in County, starting promptly at 23 24 (time), on (date). (date).".
 - (ii) One of the following statements, as applicable:
- 26 (A) "The public auction sale will be conducted in person at
 27 the place that the circuit court is held in _____ County. The
 28 mortgaged premises will be sold for cash, a cashier's check, or a
 29 wire transfer.".

- 1 (B) "The public auction sale will be held online. Details of 2 how to participate in or observe the online auction, and how the 3 mortgaged premises will be sold, may be viewed at (website 4 address).".
- 6 day of the sale. Placing the highest bid at the sale does not automatically entitle the purchaser to free and clear ownership of the property. A potential purchaser is encouraged to contact the county register of deeds office or a title insurance company, either of which may charge a fee for this information.".
- 11 (2) The party foreclosing the mortgage shall not publish a
 12 notice of foreclosure under this chapter in a newspaper in which
 13 the party foreclosing, or its agent, has a majority ownership
 14 interest.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect 16 unless Senate Bill No. 528 of the 103rd Legislature is enacted into 17 law.
