September 18, 2025, Introduced by Senators WEBBER, CHANG, WOJNO and POLEHANKI and referred to Committee on Housing and Human Services.

A bill to establish the blue envelope program; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Disability" means a physical or mental impairment that
- 3 substantially limits 1 or more major life activities of an
- 4 individual.
- 5 (b) "Program" means the blue envelope program created in

- 1 section 2.
- 2 (c) "Qualified individual" means an individual who has been
- 3 diagnosed with a disability or who has a communication impediment
- 4 designation elected under 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300, the
- 5 enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal
- 6 identification card act, 2008 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308, or the
- 7 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.
- 8 Sec. 2. (1) The blue envelope program is created within the
- 9 department of state.
- 10 (2) The department of state shall develop and administer the
- 11 program. The program must meet all of the following requirements:
- 12 (a) The program must allow a qualified individual to obtain,
- 13 at no cost, a blue envelope from any secretary of state branch
- 14 office.
- 15 (b) The blue envelope described in subdivision (a) must allow
- 16 for the inclusion of all of the following content:
- 17 (i) The qualified individual's documents and cards for
- 18 identification, contact information, and emergency contact
- 19 information.
- 20 (ii) Documents related to the qualified individual's vehicle,
- 21 including, but not limited to, vehicle registration documents and
- 22 proof of insurance.
- 23 (iii) Information concerning the qualified individual's
- 24 disability or communication impediment, including, but not limited
- 25 to, important medical information and potential physical or
- 26 emotional reactions the qualified individual may display during an
- 27 interaction with another individual.
- 28 (c) The program must provide a qualified individual, at no
- 29 cost, a sticker, bracelet, or lanyard that the qualified individual

- 1 may display or use to indicate that the qualified individual is
- 2 carrying a blue envelope and has been diagnosed with a disability
- 3 or has elected a communication impediment designation.
- 4 (3) A qualified individual may, with any interaction with a
- 5 law enforcement officer, present a blue envelope described in
- 6 subsection (2) to the officer.
