A bill to amend 1979 PA 218, entitled
"Adult foster care facility licensing act,"
by amending section 13a (MCL 400.713a), as amended by 2018 PA 557.

9 (2) The adult foster care facilities licenses fund is created
10 in the state treasury.

11 (3) The state treasurer shall credit all fees collected under
12 this act to the fund and may receive money or other assets from any
13 source for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer shall credit
14 to the fund interest and earnings from fund investments.

15 (4) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year must
16 remain in the fund and not lapse to the general fund.

17 (5) The department is the administrator of the fund for
18 auditing purposes.

19 (6) The department shall expend money from the fund, upon
20 appropriation, only to implement the programs described under this
21 act.

22 (7) At the beginning of each state fiscal year, the department
23 may increase the fees collected under this act by a percentage
24 amount equal to not more than the average percentage wage and
25 salary increase granted for that fiscal year to classified civil
26 service employees employed by the department.

27 (8) If the department increases fees under subsection (1), the
28 increase is effective for that fiscal year. The department shall
29 use the increased fees as the basis for calculating fee increases

1 in subsequent fiscal years.

2 (9) By August 1 of each year, the department shall provide to
3 the director of the department of technology, management, and
4 budget and the chairpersons of the appropriations committees of the
5 senate and house of representatives a complete schedule of fees to
6 be collected under this act for the following fiscal year.
