## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 161

Reps. DeBoer, Breen, Fox, Glanville, Paiz, Rogers and Weiss offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare September 2025 as Workforce
- 2 Development Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, In an increasingly technology-driven global economy,
- 4 a strong and skilled workforce is the foundation of Michigan's
- 5 competitive edge within the global marketplace; and
- 6 Whereas, From manufacturing and mobility to information
- 7 technology, construction, and advanced agriculture, Michigan's
- 8 evolving economy relies on a dynamic and well-supported workforce
- 9 to meet the demands of the 21st century; and
- 10 Whereas, Workforce Development Month recognizes the critical
- 11 role that education, training, apprenticeships, and career
- 12 readiness programs play in preparing Michiganders for high-quality,
- 13 in-demand jobs across the state, and celebrates the importance of

- workforce development programs and the ways they contribute to the
  growth of Michigan's residents and economy; and
- 3 Whereas, Michigan is ranked eighth in the nation for its
- 4 skilled trades workforce, which is nearly 255,000 strong. It is
- 5 through the recruiting, training and retention efforts done by
- 6 programs through career technical education in secondary schools,
- 7 community colleges, public-private partnerships, and private
- 8 employers that Michigan's workers are equipped for current and
- 9 future opportunities; and
- 10 Whereas, Grand Rapids Community College serves as an excellent
- 11 example of a regional talent engine that feeds Michigan's robust
- 12 manufacturing and innovation centers. The college supported over
- 13 12,000 students in the 2023-2024 academic year alone and offers a
- 14 wide variety of job training programs; and
- 15 Whereas, Workforce development is essential not only to the
- 16 economy but also to ensuring upward mobility and financial
- 17 independence for individuals and families in every corner of the
- 18 state; and
- 19 Whereas, It is appropriate to celebrate the individuals,
- 20 institutions, and partnerships that work day in and day out to
- 21 connect people with career pathways, close the talent gap, and
- 22 strengthen communities throughout Michigan; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That members of this
- 24 legislative body declare September 2025 as Workforce Development
- 25 Month in the state of Michigan.
