- 1 A resolution to declare September 10, 2025, as World Suicide
- 2 Prevention Day in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, World Suicide Prevention Day is observed annually on
- 4 September 10 to raise awareness about suicide prevention, honor
- 5 those lost to suicide, and support survivors and their families;

- 7 Whereas, Suicide remains a leading cause of death across the
- 8 United States, with devastating impacts on individuals, families,
- 9 and communities. In Michigan, thousands of lives are affected each
- 10 year by suicide and suicidal ideation; and
- 11 Whereas, In Michigan, suicide remains the second leading cause

- 1 of death among individuals aged 10 to 24, with over 150 youth lives
- 2 lost annually; and
- 3 Whereas, World Suicide Prevention Day serves as a reminder
- 4 that every life has value and that we must remain vigilant in
- 5 supporting those who struggle with mental health challenges; and
- 6 Whereas, Community partners, faith-based organizations,
- 7 healthcare providers, educators, and advocates across Michigan
- 8 continue to work tirelessly to implement prevention strategies,
- 9 expand access to mental health resources, and support those in
- 10 crisis; and
- 11 Whereas, We recognize the importance of reducing stigma,
- 12 encouraging honest conversations, and ensuring that individuals
- 13 know they are not alone; now, therefore, be it
- 14 Resolved, That the members of this legislative body declare
- 15 September 10, 2025, as World Suicide Prevention Day in the state of
- 16 Michigan; and be it further
- 17 Resolved, That we honor the memory of those lost to suicide,
- 18 support survivors, and encourage continued community-driven efforts
- 19 to prevent suicide and promote hope.
