- 8 Whereas, Patient safety is a vital value at the heart of
- 9 Michigan's healthcare system, which supports millions of lives and
- 10 families; and
- 11 Whereas, Every patient who entrusts their care to healthcare
- 12 professionals deserves the highest level of professionalism and
- 13 safety and this must be a top priority for all providers; and

Whereas, The World Health Organization has designated 1 September 17 as World Patient Safety Day to raise global awareness 2 about patient safety and urge people to show their commitment to 3 making healthcare safer; and 4 Whereas, Doctors and healthcare clinicians serve at the 5 6 forefront of advocacy for patient safety in healthcare settings and serve as the oversight and protection between patients and potential harm during patients' most vulnerable moments during 8 9 surgery and procedures; and 10 Whereas, Recognizing Patient Safety Day provides an 11 opportunity for all to honor healthcare workers like anesthesiologists and their unwavering commitment to protecting 12 patients every day and to remember those who have been affected by 13 preventable medical harm; now, therefore, be it 14 15 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 16 this legislative body declare September 17, 2025, as Patient Safety Day in the state of Michigan. 17
