Senators Singh and Santana offered the following resolution: A resolution to recognize September 15-19, 2025, as Septic 1 2 Smart Week. 3 Whereas, Proper septic system use and routine care are vital to protecting public health, preserving our groundwater, lakes, 4 streams, and waterways, and avoiding costly repairs that can result 5 6 from neglect; and 7 Whereas, Over 1.3 million septic systems in Michigan treat wastewater from homes and businesses which represents a significant 8 part of our state's wastewater infrastructure; and 10 Whereas, If not used and maintained properly, septic systems can become leaky, broken, or outdated and introduce nitrogen, 11 12 phosphorous, household chemicals, bacteria, viruses, and other harmful pollutants into Michigan's waters; and 13 Whereas, Wastewater professionals use their expertise in the 14

- 4 SepticSmart Program, used by Michigan health officials, educates
- 5 homeowners about the need for proper septic system use and routine

- 8 replacement loan program that assists system owners in replacing
- 9 failing septic systems; and
- 10 Whereas, Our residents and environment benefit from properly
- 11 designed, installed, operated, and maintained septic systems; now,
- 12 therefore, be it
- 13 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 14 body recognize September 15-19, 2025, as Septic Smart Week.
