

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 7

Rep. Hall offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to create the Select Committee on Protecting
2 Michigan Employees and Small Businesses.

3 Whereas, There are significant issues facing employees
4 throughout Michigan and threatening to close the doors of our
5 state's small businesses; and

6 Whereas, The pressing nature of these challenges requires
7 swift action from the Legislature to protect paychecks and support
8 the stability of our small business economy; now, therefore, be it

9 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the Select
10 Committee on Protecting Michigan Employees and Small Businesses is
11 created. The select committee shall consist of 15 members appointed
12 by the Speaker of the House, nine House Republicans and six House
13 Democrats. The Speaker of the House shall designate the
14 chairperson, majority vice chairperson, and minority vice

1 chairperson; and be it further

2 Resolved, That the select committee shall consider legislation
3 regarding Michigan's minimum wage, including the minimum wage for
4 tipped workers, and legislation regarding earned sick time. The
5 select committee may favorably report any bill back to the House.
