Rep. Lightner offered the following resolution: A resolution to declare August 31, 2025, as Overdose Awareness 1 Day in the state of Michigan. 2 Whereas, Drug overdose is the leading cause of injury-related 3 deaths in the United States; and 4 5 Whereas, The last couple of decades, drug overdose deaths have significantly increased in the state of Michigan, the majority of 6 7 which are a result of prescription opioids, illicit fentanyl (synthetic opioid), and heroin; and 8 Whereas, In 2023, the state of Michigan recorded that 2,826 9 10 people died from an overdose; and Whereas, The families and friends of overdose victims suffer 11 12 unspeakable grief and heartache from the loss of their loved ones; 13 and 14 Whereas, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

- 1 has stated that substance use and substance use disorders are
- 2 considered prominent public health issues; and
- 3 Whereas, Substance use disorder is a chronic disease that over
- 4 48.5 million Americans 12 and older have had in the last year; and
- 5 Whereas, The ongoing stigmatization of substance abuse
- 6 disorder results in many Americans not seeking the mental health
- 7 treatment and medical care they need to recover from their
- 8 addiction, resulting in increased overdose deaths; and
- 9 Whereas, Substance use disorder also has tremendous social and
- 10 economic consequences in America, including increased costs to our
- 11 health care and criminal justice systems, losses in job
- 12 productivity, threats to public safety, and the erosion of
- 13 families; and
- 14 Whereas, There are countless organizations and facilities that
- 15 put their efforts towards fighting against this epidemic, and we
- 16 are grateful for the ways that they support those in their
- 17 community to fight this disorder; now, therefore, be it
- 18 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 19 this legislative body declare August 31, 2025, as Overdose
- 20 Awareness Day in the state of Michigan.
