## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 161

Rep. DeBoer offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare September 2025 as Workforce Development Month in the state of Michigan. 2 3 Whereas, In an increasingly technology-driven global economy, a strong and skilled workforce is the foundation of Michigan's 4 5 competitive edge within the global marketplace; and 6 Whereas, From manufacturing and mobility to information 7 technology, construction, and advanced agriculture, Michigan's evolving economy relies on a dynamic and well-supported workforce 8 9 to meet the demands of the 21st century; and 10 Whereas, Workforce Development Month recognizes the critical role that education, training, apprenticeships, and career 11 12 readiness programs play in preparing Michiganders for high-quality, 13 in-demand jobs across the state, and celebrates the importance of 14 workforce development programs and the ways they contribute to the

growth of Michigan's residents and economy; and 1 2 Whereas, Michigan is ranked eighth in the nation for its skilled trades workforce, which is nearly 255,000 strong. It is 3 through the recruiting, training and retention efforts done by 4 programs through career technical education in secondary schools, 5 6 community colleges, public-private partnerships, and private 7 employers that Michigan's workers are equipped for current and 8 future opportunities; and 9 Whereas, Grand Rapids Community College serves as an excellent 10 example of a regional talent engine that feeds Michigan's robust 11 manufacturing and innovation centers. The college supported over 12 12,000 students in the 2023-2024 academic year alone and offers a wide variety of job training programs; and 13 14 Whereas, Workforce development is essential not only to the 15 economy but also to ensuring upward mobility and financial 16 independence for individuals and families in every corner of the 17 state; and Whereas, It is appropriate to celebrate the individuals, 18 19 institutions, and partnerships that work day in and day out to 20 connect people with career pathways, close the talent gap, and
