## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 162

Reps. Outman, Cavitt, Markkanen, Fairbairn and Wortz offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare September 2025 as Big Brothers Big
- 2 Sisters Youth Mentoring Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Big Brothers Big Sisters is a nationally recognized
- 4 nonprofit organization that was formed in 1904 with a vision to
- 5 help all youth achieve their full potential through the power of
- 6 one-on-one mentoring relationships with dedicated local volunteers;
- 7 and
- 8 Whereas, Michigan has long played a significant role in the
- 9 history and growth of Big Brothers Big Sisters. In 1917, the city
- 10 of Grand Rapids hosted the organization's first national
- 11 conference. Today, Michigan is home to eleven local agencies
- 12 serving communities across the state; and

Whereas, The need for caring and consistent mentors continues 1 to grow across Michigan, with thousands of children waiting to be 2 matched with a trusted adult. Strong mentoring relationships can 3 help young people build resilience, confidence, and purpose, which 4 strengthens families and communities socially, academically, and 5 6 economically; and 7 Whereas, Volunteers with Big Brothers Big Sisters, also known 8 as "Bigs", selflessly dedicate their time, wisdom, and support to thousands of children across Michigan, offering consistent 9 10 guidance, encouragement, and inspiration through lasting 11 relationships; and Whereas, Evidence-based research demonstrates that youth who 12 13 participate in quality mentoring programs, like those provided by 14 Big Brothers Big Sisters, are less likely to engage in risky 15 behaviors and more likely to perform well in school, graduate, and form healthy relationships. These outcomes benefit not only each 16 individual child, but our society as a whole; and 17 Whereas, Compared to their peers, "Littles" in Big Brothers 18 19 Big Sisters programs are 46 percent less likely to begin using 20 illegal drugs, 27 percent less likely to begin using alcohol, and 21 52 percent less likely to skip school. These statistics reflect the 22 transformative power of mentorship; and 23 Whereas, The month of September serves as a time to honor and celebrate the mentors, staff, supporters, and community partners 24 25 who make youth mentoring possible and impactful. It is also a 26 moment to raise awareness about the profound effect positive role 27 models can have in shaping the next generation of leaders; now, 28 therefore, be it
