- 6 Whereas, Since treatment only refers to a brief time of
- 7 assistance, recovery provides long-term assistance and resources to
- $oldsymbol{8}$ individuals experiencing substance use disorders; and
- 9 Whereas, Recovery organizations can help play in the larger
- 10 assistance of recovery, and lead those who suffer from addiction to
- 11 live sober and healthy lives; and
- 12 Whereas, Recovery community organizations provide meaningful

- 1 assistance and resources to individuals at a fraction of the cost
 2 of treatment; and
- Whereas, Recovery community organizations provide ongoing
 support that significantly improves the likelihood of long-term
 recovery; and
- Whereas, Recovery community organizations deserve greater
 respect and appreciation for ongoing support and assistance for
 individuals experiencing substance use disorders; and
- 9 Whereas, The month of September is recognized as National10 Recovery Month; now, therefore, be it
- Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare September 13, 2025, as Recovery Day in the state of Michigan. We support the commendable efforts of individuals striving for lifelong recovery from substance use disorders and recognize the crucial work of recovery community
