

## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 168

Reps. Arbit, Rheingans, Foreman, Martus, Myers-Phillips, Tsernoglou, Longjohn, Hope, Puri, Andrews, Breen, Fitzgerald, Conlin, Scott, MacDonell, Wooden and Steckloff offered the following resolution:

1       A resolution to urge the Trump-Vance Administration to cease  
2 and desist from their radical policies of state socialism,  
3 including the partial nationalization of Intel Corporation, and  
4 encourage the federal government to refrain from any further  
5 nationalization of private corporations, so that free market  
6 capitalism may flourish in Michigan and across the United States.

7       Whereas, The United States has long thrived under a system of  
8 free enterprise and market-driven capitalism, which has spurred  
9 innovation, created millions of jobs, and lifted generations of  
10 Americans into prosperity; and

11       Whereas, The Trump-Vance Administration has undertaken an

1 alarming step toward state socialism by entering into an agreement  
2 to partially nationalize Intel Corporation, a private-sector leader  
3 in the semiconductor industry, thereby undermining the independence  
4 of private enterprise and threatening the competitive forces that  
5 drive technological advancement; and

6       Whereas, The nationalization of any private corporation sets a  
7 dangerous precedent, inviting further federal intrusion into the  
8 private sector, chilling investment, reducing efficiency, and  
9 replacing the judgment of entrepreneurs and innovators with the  
10 heavy hand of centralized government planners; and

11       Whereas, The people of Michigan, whose livelihoods depend on a  
12 thriving and competitive economy - particularly in sectors such as  
13 manufacturing, automotive, and advanced technology - have a direct  
14 stake in preserving the freedom of markets from unnecessary  
15 government control; and

16       Whereas, State socialism erodes the very foundation of  
17 American prosperity, shifting risk and decision-making from private  
18 actors accountable to shareholders, workers, and consumers to  
19 government officials accountable only to political expediency; now,  
20 therefore, be it

21       Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we urge the  
22 Trump-Vance Administration to cease and desist from their radical  
23 policies of state socialism, including the partial nationalization  
24 of Intel Corporation, which threaten the basis of American  
25 capitalism on which Michigan companies thrive; and be it further

26       Resolved, That we encourage the federal government to refrain  
27 from any further nationalization of private corporations and to  
28 allow free market capitalism to flourish without socialist  
29 government intervention, so that innovation, competition, and

1 prosperity may continue to define the American economy; and be it  
2 further

3       Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the  
4 President of the United States, the Vice President of the United  
5 States, the Majority and Minority Leaders of the United States  
6 Senate, the Speaker and Minority Leader of the United States House  
7 of Representatives, and the members of the Michigan congressional  
8 delegation.
