HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 176

Reps. Neyer, Markkanen, Cavitt, Bohnak, Alexander, DeSana, Schmaltz, BeGole, Borton, Fairbairn, Kuhn, Jenkins-Arno, Schriver, Martin, Woolford, Rigas, Kelly, Kunse, Slagh, Mentzer, Witwer and VanderWall offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare September 22-26, 2025, as Farm Safety 2 and Health Week in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, In the United States, Michigan is considered one of
- 4 the most diverse agricultural states, leading the nation in the
- 5 production of a large variety of crops, including blueberries, dry
- 6 beans, fresh flowers, pickling cucumbers, and tart cherries; and
- 7 Whereas, There were approximately 44,000 farms in the state of
- 8 Michigan last year. All these farms and their farmers contribute to
- 9 making agriculture the second-largest influencer in Michigan's
- 10 economy; and
- 11 Whereas, Agriculture is considered one of the most dangerous

1 industries because the tasks farmers take on day to day are often

- 2 physically demanding, come with a higher risk of machinery
- 3 accidents, and could potentially expose them to hazardous
- 4 chemicals. This is especially true during the busy peak season of
- 5 autumn; and
- 6 Whereas, Since 1944, the third week of September has been
- 7 recognized as National Farm Safety and Health Week, to promote the
- 8 health and well-being of those who work in the agricultural sector;
- 9 and
- 10 Whereas, This year's theme for National Farm Safety and Health
- 11 Week is "Avoid the Worst," focusing on a variety of areas like
- 12 equipment and rural roadway safety, the importance of farmer's
- 13 health and wellness, keeping youth safe on the farm, handling
- 14 agricultural confined spaces, and the safe operation of ATVs and
- 15 UTVs in farming; and
- 16 Whereas, National Farm Safety and Health Week not only
- 17 provides an opportunity to acknowledge and appreciate the crucial
- 18 and demanding work that Michigan farmers do to put food on our
- 19 tables, but allows us to pause and refresh ourselves on the various
- 20 steps we can take to keep our farmers safe; now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 22 this legislative body declare September 22-26, 2025, as Farm Safety
- 23 and Health Week in the state of Michigan.
