

FAMILY CHILD CARE NETWORKS ACT (EXCERPT)
Act 108 of 2022

722.1605 Family child care networks; framework.

Sec. 5.

(1) Upon appropriation, the department shall establish the family child care networks to support home-based child care providers. Funding must be dispersed equitably in a manner determined by the department with family child care networks in every region in this state.

(2) The department shall convene stakeholders to develop a framework for family child care networks based on the needs of providers. The framework must include, at least, the following:

- (a) Business supports.
- (b) Connections to peers.
- (c) Operational supports.
- (d) Program quality support.
- (e) Training and technical assistance.
- (f) Engaging new providers.
